Hello Louise! Many years ago, when I was hired at Duquesne, I first saw the job ad through a posting to the Indigenous Psychology listserv. Now it's eight years later, I'm department chair, and we are once again hiring. Would you be willing to circulate this to the group, and anyone else you think might be interested? Thanks, Elizabeth

The Duquesne Psychology Department is hiring two faculty positions to start in AY '23-'24. One is a <u>tenure-track Assistant Professor</u>, and the other is a <u>Clinical Assistant Professor</u>. Our department has an APA-accredited Ph.D program in clinical psychology – one of the very few with an existential-humanistic orientation, so we attract very strong graduate students – and a robust undergraduate program. We emphasize qualitative, meaning-centered research paradigms and strive to understand psychology in its cultural, relational, historical and embodied contexts. We're particularly seeking applications from candidates whose background and experience prepare them to contribute to our ongoing work toward diversity and inclusion in higher education. International applicants are welcome.

For the Assistant Professor position, we are especially hoping to hire someone interested in community-engaged research (interpreted broadly) as Duquesne has a strong and growing focus in that area; there are start-up funds associated with this position for a community-engaged line of research that involves both graduate and undergraduate student mentorship. However, area of expertise is open; we encourage applicants from psychology as well as from related disciplines to apply. Duquesne has a long history of work in philosophical and existential-phenomenological psychology and we welcome applicants who work in this tradition.

For the Clinical Assistant Professor position, we are looking for someone who cares deeply about psychotherapy and will want to continue their own practice while also teaching in our graduate and undergraduate program and providing supervision to graduate students in our training clinic. Psychodynamic, existential and humanistic psychology have a strong presence in our department, and we are open to a variety of orientations for this position.
