Call for papers for book on Native American Psychosocial Identity and Worldview editor Gene Hightower PhD

I am seeking papers that broadly address topics on Native American identity and worldview. I am seeking two or three papers to add to a mostly complete manuscript. Papers should be approximately thirty pages double spaced and written in APA style.

Authors should have completed their graduate training.

Articles written in "Native voice" and from an Native American perspective are sought. Papers should focus on descendants of the original peoples of North America and Hawaii. Examples of topics related to the broad domain of Native American Identity and Worldview would be: Traditional cultural values, healing / spiritual traditions, relationship to the land, communication styles and etiquette, family systems, attitudes towards child rearing, mixed race identity, different types of Indian Identity (controversy surrounding enrollment, self report on US Census, family ties, and/or DNA tests), gender identity/roles, women's issues, two spirit people, maintaining sobriety, effective coping with prejudice and historical trauma, Indian politics and factors that promote positive mental health and stable identity in tribal, rural or urban settings.

Papers would be due, preferably, by late November.
