Why? and To What?": There has been much debate on whether generalization is a concept that can be applied to qualitative research or not. Famously, Lincoln and Guba (1985) argued that generalization is not a property of qualitative methods but that readers engage in transferability in which they decide how to apply findings to their contexts. In this SQIP Salon discussion, three methodologists present arguments for the inclusion of generalization as a core qualitative research practice. Referencing their papers from an upcoming special issue of Qualitative Psychology, each presenter takes a distinctive tact to advancing the relevance of generalization in qualitative methods.
